## 5. NEASC Candidacy Visit

SC members were urged to be available in Beirut on Tuesday, April 17 in the afternoon in case NEASC team members request them for specific meetings. LAU hopes to receive the official report from the Commission within 2 weeks after the visit. The time span between candidacy and accreditation ranges between 2 to 5 years. Finally, the objective of the NEASC candidacy visit is to make sure that LAU was accurate and candid in its self-study, and that the institution is committed to the stated projections.

Concerns were raised by SC members about the upcoming NEASC candidacy visit and were addressed by Dr. Sfeir.

Faculty were urged to encourage qualified students to respond to the NSSE and to fill in the FSSE themselves.
